DEPART FROM DELHI TO RISHIKESH BY 10:30 PM (BY AC SLEEPER VOLVO)

- We depart from Delhi (RK Ashram/ Kashmiri Gate) around 10:30 PM in an AC Sleeper Volvo. (Know the true value of time snatch, seize, and enjoy every moment of it.)
- Pit stop for dinner at any decent roadside restaurant

NOTE: THE PICKUP POINT WILL BE ISBT (NEAR KASHMERE GATE METRO STATION)





REACH RISHIKESH | RISHIKESH TO JOSHIMATH TRANSFER | OVERNIGHT STAY AT JOSHIMATH

- You will be picked up sharp at 6:30 AM from Rishikesh and drive to Joshimath(a town Chamoli District of Uttarakhand) by surface 290 kms approx 8-9 hrs.
- Spend the day exploring Joshimath, visit the famous temples like Narasimha Temple and Shankaracharya Math.





JOSHIMATH TO PULNA | TREK TO GHANGARIA | OVERNIGHT STAY AT GHANGARIA

- After early morning breakfast, a small briefing session would be provided where all the necessary details about the Valley of flowers trek would be shared.
- After which, we will head towards Pulna which is the starting point of this trek.
- We will start trekking toward Ghangaria village
- We will reach Ghangaria village by afternoon, Post check in we will have lunch in our hotel.
- Later we will have our dinner followed by overnight stay in the hotel.





GHANGARIA TO VALLEY OF FLOWER | BACK TO GHANGARIA | OVERNIGHT STAY AT GHANGARIA

- It's going to be a tiring day, have good breakfast, pull up your socks and kick start the day.
- We will head towards Forest check post.
- Mindway we will have a break to have lunch which we will carry in packed form.
- After reaching Forest check post, we will move towards Vallley of flowers, the main attraction of the whole trek.
- After spending some quality time at the Valley of flowers we will start descending to Ghangaria Village.
- Later we will have our dinner followed by overnight stay in the hotel.





GHANGARIA TO HEMKUND SAHIB | BACK TO GHANGARIA | OVERNIGHT STAY AT GHANGARIA

- Have breakfast and start your trek to Gurudwara Shri Hemkund Sahib Ji (World's highest gurudwara sahib).
- We will have our packed lunch while trekking to Gurudwara Sahib.
- We will reach Gurudwara sahib by afternoon and we will stay there for a while.
- Later start descending back to Ghangaria Village.
- After\treaching back to the village we will get refresh before having our dinner.
- Post dinner, Overnight stay.





GHANGARIA TO GOVINDGHAT TO JOSHIMATH | OVERNIGHT STAY AT JOSHIMATH

- Wake up and have breakfast.
- Post brekfast we will start our trek to Govindghat.
- Upon reaching Govindghat later we move to joshimath by evening we will check in to our respective accomodation.
- Post check in, lunch will be served.
- Dham and Mana village on your own.
- Dinner will be served by evening.
- Overnight stay at joshimath





JOSHIMATH TO RISHIKESH | OVERNIGHT JOURNEY TO DELHI

- Wake up to see the first ray of sun flalling on the mountains.
- Have breakfast and check out the hotel/homestay.
- We will reach Rishikesh by evening.
- Now bid an adieu to your fellow travelers and head towards Delhi

CANCELLATION POLICY

In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)

If the cancellation is from Capture A Trip's end, 100% of the package amount is refundable.

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
- 30 Days prior for Domestic trips
- 45 Days prior for International trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:

- You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
- You can shift to a later date.
- You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

Please read them carefully before proceeding.

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Weekend Trips- INR 3000
- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.

- Weekend trips- 7-10 days
- Domestic GIT- 15-20 days
- International GIT- 30-45 days
- Customised Trips- 20 days before the departure date



SAFETY & CONDUCT:

- Capture A Trip and it's organizers strictly prohibit the utilization of any Narcotics and banned substances during the tours. Violation may lead to the customer being removed from the trip without a refund.
- We reserve the rights to evict any camper anytime without any refund if his/her actions violate any camp rules or incase of any misbehavior with other co-travellers.
- We are also not responsible for your whereabouts or safety if you are outside the camping premises.
- Any loss of camping materials such as tents, pillows, mattresses or any property belonging to the campsite will be subject to full payment of the Product MRP.

ACCOMMODATION GUIDELINES:

- Air-conditioned rooms may not be available at certain locations, such as European cities or hill stations within India.
- Hot water availability is not guaranteed at all locations.
- Customers are responsible for any damage to rooms or property during their stay.
- Only Customers officially booked with Capture A Trip will be allowed to access the Hotels/campsites,/Homestays. If you plan to invite any external guests, you must notify us in advance and obtain prior approval.
- Hotels/Campsite/Homestays slots are confirmed only upon full payment.
- Capture A Trip reserves the right to change hotel arrangements due to unforeseen circumstances and arrange suitable alternatives. The customer shall be informed about the same as soon as possible.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

- It is the customer's responsibility to carry all necessary travel documents, including a valid passport, visa, and permits, if any. Capture A Trip will not be held responsible for delays or cancellations due to missing or invalid documents.
- We offer assistance with the visa process if needed; however, visa approval is entirely subject to approval by the concerned embassy.
- Customers holding ECR passports may need an 'OK to Board' (OTB) approval, depending on the destination. It is important to check and arrange this in advance.
- Passports must be valid for at least six months from the return date to India. For domestic travel, a government-issued photo ID is mandatory.
- All customers must carry a valid government-issued photo ID at all times during the trip, including check-ins, travel, and activities.
