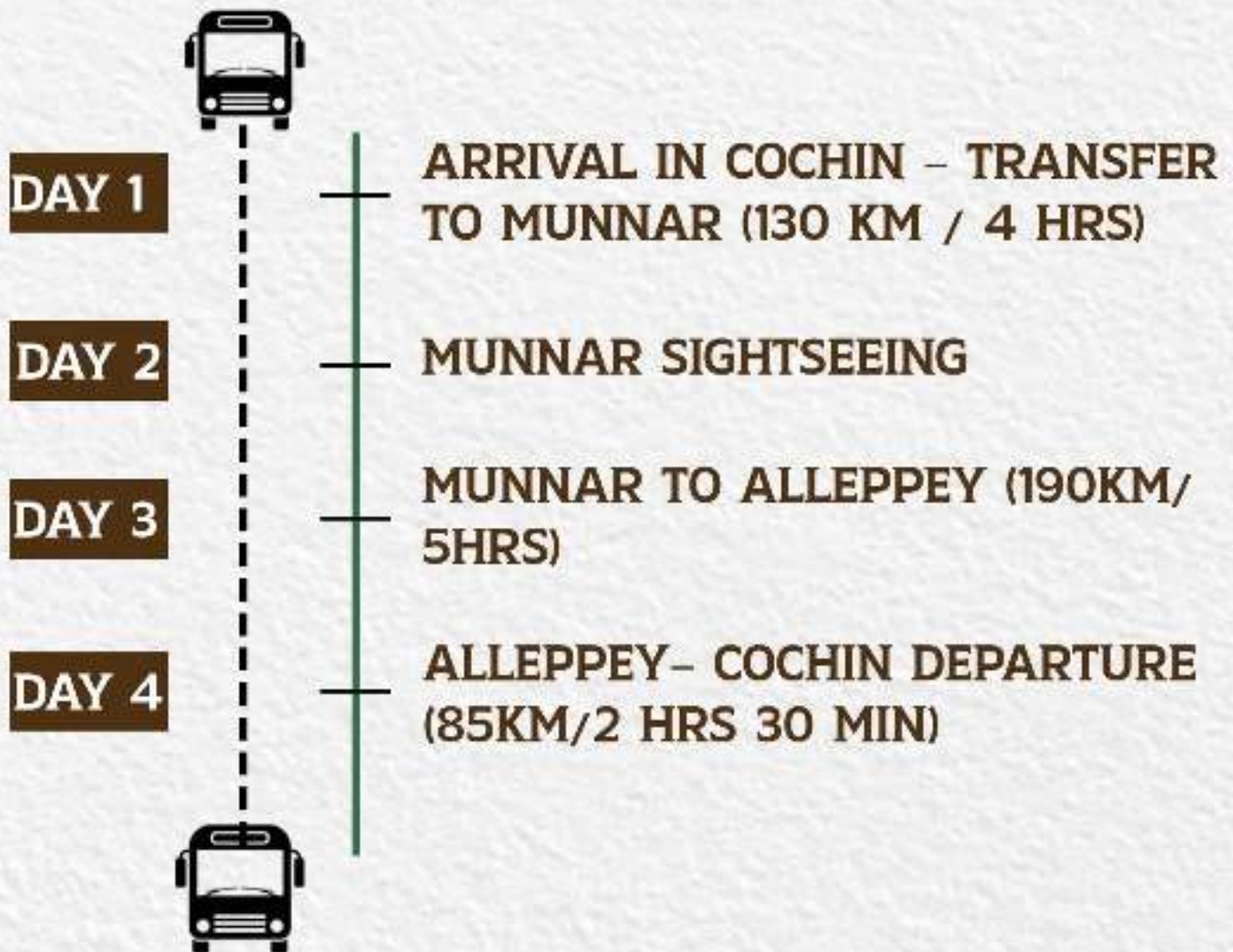

Brief Itinerary





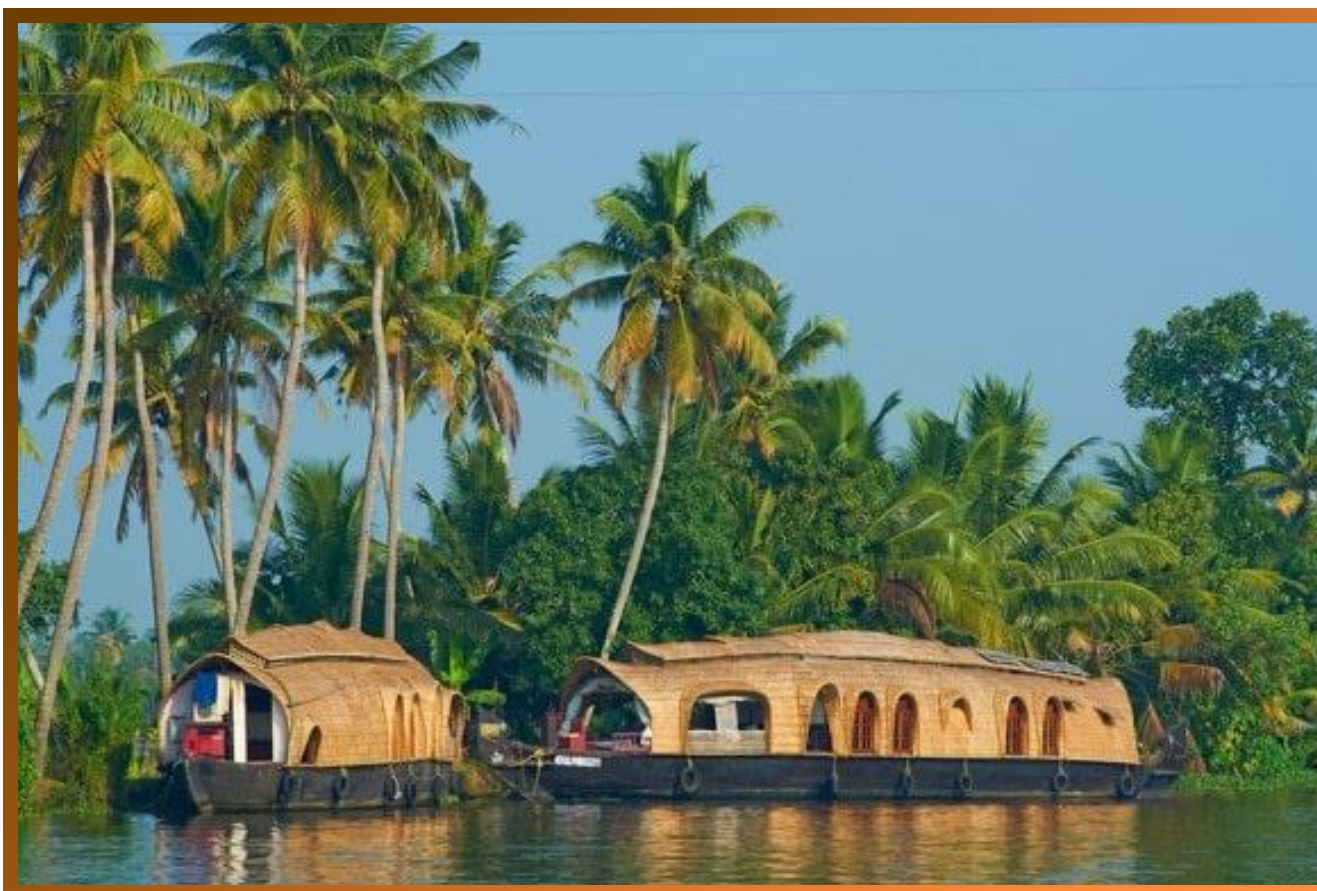
DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN COCHIN – TRANSFER TO MUNNAR (130 KM / 4 HRS)

- *Pick-up from Cochin Airport or Railway Station.*

- *En route, explore the lush Spice Plantations and enjoy the breathtaking Cheeyappara Waterfalls and Valara Waterfalls (seasonal).*
- *Stop by Karadippara Viewpoint for panoramic views of tea gardens.*
- *Optional adventure: Try the thrilling Zip Line experience.*
- *Upon arrival in Munnar, transfer to your hotel.*
- *Overnight stay at Munnar.*



DAY 2: MUNNAR SIGHTSEEING

- *Start the day with a hearty breakfast.*
- *Explore Munnar with a full-day sightseeing tour, visiting iconic places like Mattupetty Dam, Kundala Lake, and Echo Point.*
- *In the afternoon, visit Eravikulam National Park (Rajamala – closed during Feb/Mar).*
- *Evening highlights include a visit to the Tea Factory/Tea Gardens, Rose Garden, Blossom Park, and Tea Museum (closed on Mondays).*
- *Overnight stay in Munnar.*



DAY 3: MUNNAR TO ALLEPPEY (190KM/5HRS)

- *Start your day with a hearty breakfast at the hotel.*
- *Check out and proceed to Alleppey renowned for its picturesque backwaters.*
- *Upon arrival, check in to your hotel or resort and unwind.*
- *Alleppey is a stunning blend of small islands, known for its enchanting backwaters, expansive paddy fields, mangrove forests, and coconut groves.*
- *Opt for a serene Shikara Ride (available at an additional cost) or simply enjoy a relaxed and leisurely day at the resort.*
- *End your day with an overnight stay at the hotel or resort.*



DAY 4: ALLEPPEY– COCHIN DEPARTURE (85KM/2 HRS 30 MIN)

- *Enjoy breakfast at the hotel/resort.*
- *After checkout, proceed to Cochin for your departure.*
- *If time allows, explore Cochin's vibrant shopping and sightseeing spots, including Fort Kochi, Mattancherry, and the historic Jew Synagogue.*
- *You will be dropped off at Cochin Airport or Railway Station for your onward journey.*
