



About Kerala

Brief Itinerary





DAY 1: COCHIN TO MUNNAR (130 KM / 4 HRS)

- Pick up from Cochin Airport or Railway Station.
- Proceed towards Munnar (140 km / 4.30 hrs) through scenic routes.
- Visit the Spice Plantation en route.
- Stop at the stunning Cheeyappara Waterfalls, Valara Waterfalls (seasonal), Karadippara Viewpoint, and enjoy the view of lush Tea Gardens.
- Optional adventure: Zip Lining for a thrilling experience.
- Upon arrival, check-in at your hotel in Munnar.
- Overnight stay in Munnar.



DAY 2: MUNNAR SIGHTSEEING

- Start the day with a hearty breakfast.
- Explore Munnar with a full-day sightseeing tour, visiting iconic places like Mattupetty Dam, Kundala Lake, and Echo Point.
- In the afternoon, visit Eravikulam National Park (Rajamala closed during Feb/Mar).
- Evening highlights include a visit to the Tea Factory/Tea Gardens, Rose Garden, Blossom Park, and Tea Museum (closed on Mondays).
- Overnight stay in Munnar.



DAY 3: MUNNAR TO ALLEPPEY/KUMARAKOM (155 KM / 4 HRS)

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.
- Check out and head towards the beautiful backwaters of Alleppey/Kumarakom.
- Upon arrival, check-in at your hotel or resort.
- Experience the serene charm of Alleppey/Kumarakom, with its small islands, scenic backwaters, paddy fields, mangrove forests, and coconut groves.
- Opt for a peaceful Shikara Ride (at an additional cost) or spend a leisurely evening at the resort.
- Overnight stay in Alleppey/Kumarakom.




DAY 4: ALLEPPEY/KUMARAKOM TO KOVALAM (170 KM / 4.30 HRS)

- Begin the day with breakfast at the hotel or resort.
- Check out and proceed to Kovalam.
- En route, visit the spectacular Jatayu Earth Centre (Jatayu Park).
- Upon arrival in Kovalam, check-in at your hotel.
- Spend your evening relaxing on the beautiful beaches of Kovalam.
- Overnight stay in Kovalam.



DAY 5: KOVALAM - TRIVANDRUM SIGHTSEEING

- After breakfast, head out for a full-day exploration of Trivandrum.
- Visit the iconic Padmanabhaswamy Temple, followed by Srichitra Art Gallery, Napier Museum, Trivandrum Zoo, Shangumugham Beach, and indulge in shopping at Lulu Mall.
- Return to Kovalam by evening.
- Overnight stay in Kovalam.



DAY 6: KOVALAM – TRIVANDRUM DEPARTURE (15 KM / 30 MIN)

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.
- Check out and transfer to Trivandrum for your departure.
- Drop off at Trivandrum Airport or Railway Station for your onward journey.
