- **Famous Casino-Casino Everest, and Casino Mahjong ,Casino Royale**

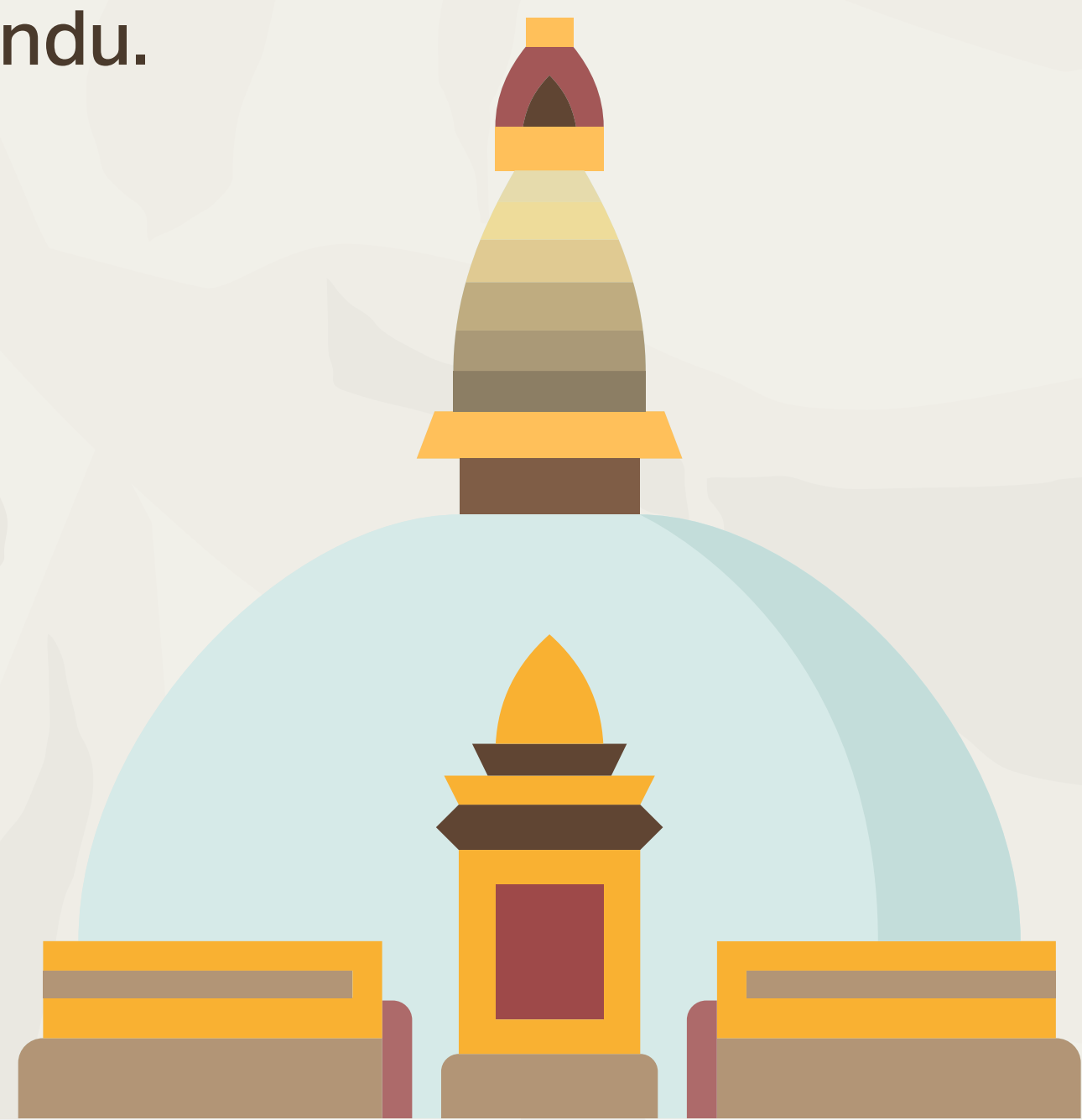




DAY 2

CHANDRAGIRI HILLS & CABLE CAR, PASHUPATINATH TEMPLE & BOUDHANATH STUPA EXPLORATION

- Drive to Thankot, about 17 km from Kathmandu, and take the cable car ride to Chandragiri Hills for stunning panoramic views of the Kathmandu Valley.

- Soak in the natural beauty and tranquility before descending back to the base via the cable car.
- Return to the hotel stay in Kathmandu.

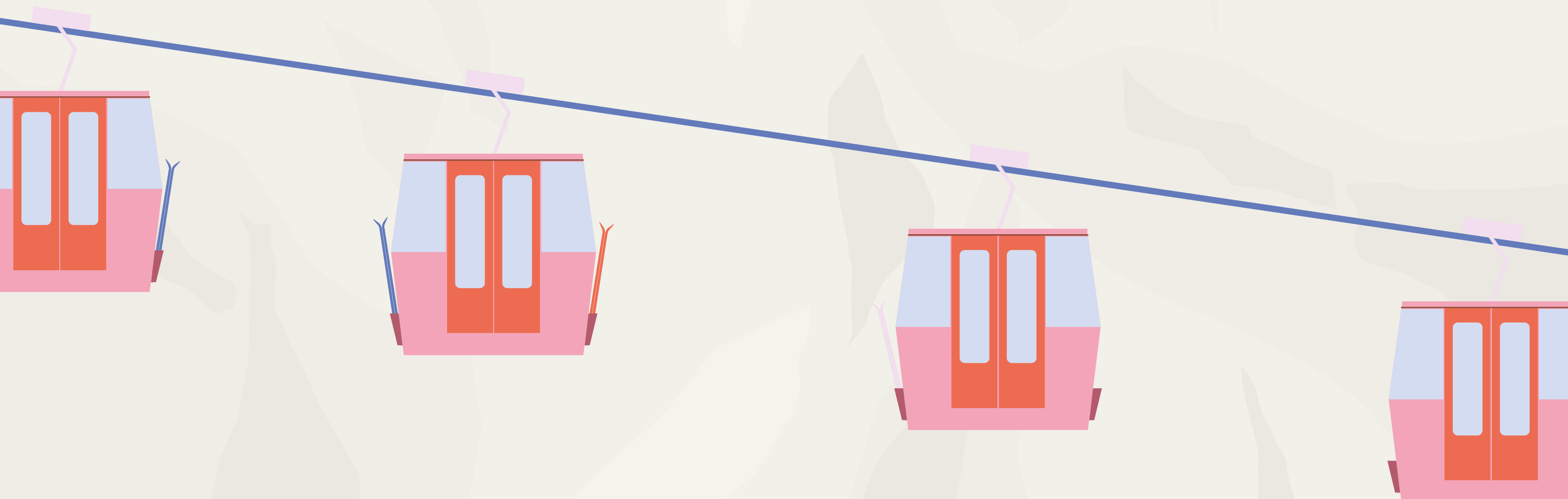




DAY 3

DRIVE TO POKHARA RAFTING RAFTING MANAKAMANA TEMPLE

- Visit the revered Manakamana Temple via a 10-minute cable car ride, soaking in spiritual and scenic vibes.
- Manakamana Temple – A sacred hilltop shrine dedicated to Goddess Bhagwati, believed to grant wishes., offering beautiful views of the Trishuli River and surrounding landscapes.
- Continue your scenic drive through lush hills and river valleys toward Pokhara.
- Reach Pokhara by evening and enjoy self-exploration around Lakeside Market.
- Stay in pokhara.
- Discover the vibrant nightlife at popular clubs like City Walk, Club 16, Busy Bee, and Club Catwalk.





DAY 4

ADVENTURE ACTIVITIES | DEVI'S FALL | SETI GORGE, | GUPTESHWOR CAVE

- Morning free for optional adventure activities such as paragliding, bungee jumping, ultralight flights, or ziplining.
- Visit Bindebasini Temple, one of the oldest in Pokhara, with views of the Himalayas and a stroll through the nearby old bazaar.
- Explore Devi's Fall, a dramatic waterfall especially powerful during the monsoon season.
- Discover the sacred Gupteshwor Cave, known for its natural limestone formations (photography not allowed inside).
- Witness the striking Seti Gorge, carved by the Seti River, with its deep chasm and rushing waters.
- End the day with an optional boat ride on scenic Phewa Lake, followed by an overnight stay at the hotel in Pokhara.

FLY BACK TO KATHMANDU – NAGARKOT SCENIC VIEW & RANI JHULA

- Enjoy a short 30-minute flight from Pokhara to Kathmandu, with crisp morning air.
- Visit the historic Bhaktapur Durbar Square, filled with ancient palaces and temples.
- Make a brief stop at Rani Jhula, a thrilling suspension bridge.
- Head toward Nagarkot, passing through lush hills, eager for the stunning Himalayan sunset.

- The vehicle will not be on disposal and will be provided as per the program only.

- Ask permission before taking photos of people or religious sites.
- Respect local customs, rituals, and prayer times.
- Support local businesses, guides, and artisans.
- Be polite and sensitive when discussing politics or religion.
- Carry out all waste and follow Leave No Trace principles when trekking.



DONT'S

- Don't show public displays of affection.
- Don't step over religious offerings or sacred objects.
- Don't touch anyone's head or point feet at people/shrines.
- Don't bring leather goods into Hindu temples.
- Don't criticize religion, monarchy, or politics publicly.
- Don't enter temples if signs prohibit non-Hindus.
- Don't litter or damage natural and cultural sites.
- Don't give money to begging children—support NGOs instead.
- Don't go trekking without permits or guides in restricted areas.
- Don't take photos where it's clearly prohibited.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In case of any cancellations made from the customer's end, the booking amount of the package stands non-refundable. (As all the bookings related to transportation, accommodations, and other services are made in advance, costing more than the booking amount at times)

If the cancellation is from Capture A Trip's end, 100% of the package amount is refundable.

In case of rescheduling or cancellations with prior notice, please follow these timelines for the communication:

- 15 Days prior for Weekend trips/Treks
- 30 Days prior for Domestic trips
- 45 Days prior for International trips

Free rescheduling is available. If cancelled, the amount will be refunded as a credit note valid for 2 years.

In case of cancellations due to government restrictions, natural calamities, protests or any unforeseen circumstances, the cancellations or its alternatives will be as follows:

- You can shift to any other scheduled departure on the same weekend.
- You can shift to a later date.
- You can get 100% of the booking amount as a credit note (valid for 2 years for any fixed departure).

PAYMENT AND BOOKING TERMS:

To confirm your booking with Capture A Trip, a non-refundable booking amount is required at the time of reservation. All packages are subject to change based on real-time availability and pricing at the time of final payment. Any updates related to your package, such as changes in hotels, airlines, or itinerary, will be provided as soon as possible.

BOOKING AMOUNTS FOR:

- Domestic GIT- INR 5000
- International GIT- INR 10000
- Customised trips- 30% of the package amount

The customers are required to make a full payment within the specified time frames before the date of departure. Non-payment of the full amount by the due date may lead to cancellation of your booking or associated services by Capture A Trip.
