

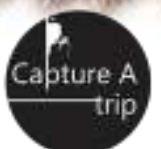

About Destination

Bir is a village located in the west of Joginder Nagar Valley in the state of Himachal Pradesh in northern India. Mostly referred as “Paragliding Capital of India”, Bir is also a noted center for ecotourism, spiritual studies and meditation.

While Billing is the takeoff site for paragliding and Bir village is for landing; collectively it is known “Bir Billing”. Kasol is a hamlet in the district Kullu of the Indian state of Himachal Pradesh. It is situated in Parvati Valley, on the banks of the Parvati River,

on the way between Bhuntar and Manikaran .. The valley appears lush green during summers and monsoon with Pine forests surrounding the slopes of the huge mountains.



DAY 1: DEPART FROM DELHI

- We **depart from Delhi** around 5:30 PM in an AC Vehicle.

(Know the true value of time, snatch, seize, and enjoy every moment of it.)



DAY 02: Reach Bir- Lunch And Self-Explore Bir Village.

- Reach **Bir** by morning.
- Have breakfast and freshen up, head out for the sightseeing. Visit **Monasteries** around the village and engage with the monks.
- After lunch start the journey to Billing. Enjoy the **Panoramic views** of the sunset.
- Check-In to the camps
- Bonfire and dinner.



DAY 3: PARAGLIDING

- Wake up to a beautiful morning and get yourself fresh.
- After breakfast, meet your pilots at the take off point(BILLING) and experience the 25-35 min **paragliding from Billing to Bir.**
- After that, we will start the scenic drive to Kasol.
- Check-in to the Hotel
- Bonfire and Dinner.



DAY 04: KASOL AND PARVATI VALLEY

- Soak in the peace & beauty of Parvati Valley.
- You can explore the **Kasol** market, and try Israil dishes at the local **Hippie Cafes**, or just relax by the Parvati River.
- In the evening, go for a hike to **Chalal village** and capture some beautiful views of Parvati Valley.
- Chill at the cafe's in Kasol and return to the Hotel for an night stay.



DAY 05: TOSH AND TREK TO TOSH WATERFALL

- Wake up early morning and after having breakfast, head for tosh by taxi.
- Arrive **tosh** in afternoon, Camps Check-In
- Enjoy your walk in the heart of the beautiful Parvati valley with a stunning view of snowcapped mountains all around
- Do small **trek to tosh waterfalls** from tosh village..
- Back to campsite in evening, have your dinner & at bonfire under the sky with billion of stars and snowcapped mountains all around.
- Sleep overnight in the camps and have an experience of a lifetime.



Day 6: Trek Down From Tosh - Evening Departure To Delhi

- Start trekking down to reach to Kasol.
- On the way, visit the **Manikaran Gurudwara**.
- By evening, depart back to Delhi with some amazing memories of the trip
- Overnight journey from **Kasol to Delhi**.

DURING TRAVEL

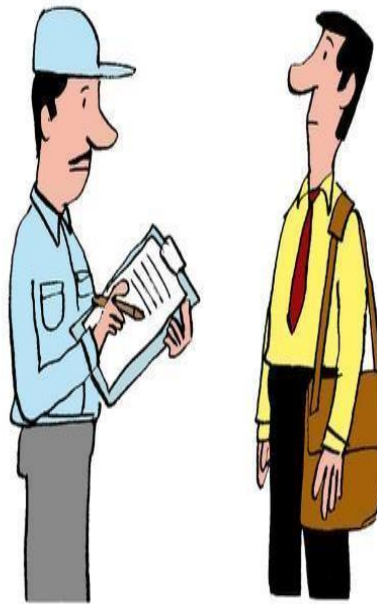


Wash hands regularly and stay at least one meter away from people who are coughing or sneezing.
